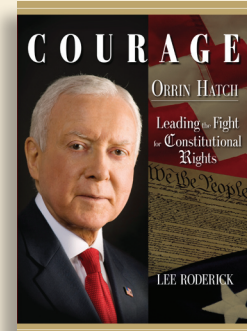

## New Book Says Hatch is Pivotal to Fixing Washington

The United States Government, in an astonishingly short time, has spent us into deep dependence and narrowed the nation's possibilities, writes author Lee Roderick. He believes conservative Republican Senator Orrin Hatch is pivotal to restoring the economy.
